Directions by train

Keighley Assessment Centre is located 0.2 miles from the station. Upon leaving the station, turn left and walk through the Inland Revenue entrance on the corner of Coney Lane junction with East Parade.

Directions by bus

The nearest bus stop to the Assessment Centre is Worth Way, less than 400 feet away. Upon leaving the bus, walk up Worth Way and take a slight right to stay on the road. The Assessment Centre is on the right.

Directions by car

From Shipley/Bradford: Approach Keighley on the A650. At the roundabout, take the first exit onto Bradford Road (A6035), heading towards the station. Continue along Bradford Road and East Parade onto Worth Way. The Centre is on the left.

From Skipton: Approach Keighley on the A629. At the roundabout, turn left towards Bradford on the A650. At the next roundabout, turn right onto Bradford Road (A6035), heading towards the station. Continue on East Parade and onto Worth Way. The Centre is on the left.

From Haworth: Follow Halifax Road (A629) to the traffic lights. Turn right into Worth Way. The Centre is on the left.
