Directions by train

Stirling railway station is approximately 0.8 miles from the Assessment Centre. Upon leaving the station, turn right onto Station Road then take a left onto Murray Place. Take another slight left onto Port Street and continue onto St Ninians Road. Stay on St Ninians Road until you reach The Woodlands bus stop, then take a right. The Assessment Centre is on the right.



Directions by car

From Glasgow/Edinburgh: Leave the motorway at junction 9. Take the A872 following the brown tourist signs for Stirling Castle/Bannockburn Heritage Centre. At Boreston/St Ninians roundabout take the B8051 (left), which leads to St Ninians Road. Take a left turn for the Assessment Centre.

From North: Leave the M9 Motorway at junction 10. Take the Stirling exit then follow the Ring Road/Castle Business Park Signs at the next two roundabouts. At the mini-roundabout, turn left (Dumbarton Road) and then take the first right onto Queens Road. Continue to follow signs for Ring Road/Stirling Royal Infirmary. At the traffic lights, turn right. The Assessment Centre is on the first right.



Directions by bus

The closest bus stop to the Assessment Centre is The Woodlands, directly opposite the Assessment Centre.
