Directions by train

Sunderland Central train station is located 0.4 miles from the Assessment Centre. Upon leaving the station, walk up Burdon Road and continue onto Fawcett Street, then turn left onto High Street. Turn right onto Cumberland Street, then take a right onto St Mary's Way for the Centre. Alternatively, the closest metro stop is Sunderland Metro Station (0.2 miles).

Directions by bus

The nearest bus stop to the Assessment Centre is City Hall, directly outside the Centre.

Directions by car

From Newcastle/A184: From Tyne Bridge, cross then use the middle lane to continue on Gateshead Highway. At the roundabout, take the first exit onto Park Lane and continue until Testo's junction. Take the third exit onto the A1290 slip road.

At Hylton Grange interchange, take the first exit onto Wessington Way, and stay on it via the second exit at the roundabout. At the next roundabout, stay on Wessington Way by taking the third exit. Turn right onto Northern Spire Bridge, then take the second exit at the roundabout onto Silksworth Row. At the following roundabout, take the first exit onto Livingstone Road.
